1.	Welcome & Apologies
	Dr L Grewal welcomed all to the meeting, apologies for the meeting were noted as above.
2.	Minutes of the meeting held on 12th August 2014
	The minutes of the meeting held on the 12 th August 2014 were reviewed by the group and agreed as an accurate account.
3.	Primary Care – WIC
	<p>Ms M Ansell introduced Ms R Halksworth to the group.</p> <p>It was explained that the Thurrock Health Centre is coming to the end of its contract in March 2015. The walk-in element of the service is the responsibility of the CCG. This, along with the 'list' element both need to be retendered. A primary care working group has been set up to discuss the way forward, however it is important to have the view of the GP's of Thurrock.</p> <p>Ms R Halksworth provided the group with a presentation regarding the process going forward. The group were asked to discuss in localities 3 questions. Following these discussions, a small amount of feedback was requested from each group:</p> <p>Feedback</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dr L Grewal – patient expectation is 8-8. Waiting times of 2-3 hours. Patients records not being correctly updated. Information sharing poor. Walk-in element not needed as surgeries have emergency appointments for these patients. We already have out of hours GP cover. The money could be used to improve reception services within practices. Money could be used to increase Nurse Hours or increase Nurse Practitioners. Some patients use the walk-in service for second opinions and patient convenience. - Dr E Shehadah – The walk-in centre should be for the hard to reach. It should also assist with relieving pressure on A&E. - Dr R Arhin – Suggest for the out of hours service to be moved from the current location to the walk in centre, integration of services. Extend practices to other elements of access - Dr N Tressider – There is no good access for all patients, this should be for clinical need not want. Close the walk in centre and re invest money into GP practices. <p>All feedback received from each table will be collated and circulated to the group.</p>
4.	Primary Care Transformation Fund Explanation
	<p>Dr A Deshpande presented to the group the primary care transformation fund.</p> <p>Dr N Tressider stated that practices that use the Hurley group on NHS Choices are the lowest rated. Also most of the patients that need GPs in the area are either the very young or very elderly.</p>

	<p>Julie (Practice Nurse) suggested nurse led localised clinics for the young and those with long term conditions, with access to a GP if needed. Dr A Deshpande suggested that a business case should be completed. Dr A Deshpande stated that this has to be practice involved.</p>
5.	Practice Issues/Concerns
	<p>Any issues to be reported:</p> <p>Dr S Gorai asked for an update given for full authorisation for the CCG and asked if there is additional funding following authorisation. Dr L Grewal confirmed that we are doing well and have been commended. Legal directions, this is a discussion between Dr A Deshpande and Mr A Pike. We will ask for an update to go out to the practices from the Chair. Once authorised our budget will remain the same. Dr L Grewal confirmed that if training is required contact Ms C Celentano and this can be arranged. Action AD/CC</p> <p>Dr A Pattara asked if we have an Accountable Officer at present. Dr A Deshpande confirmed that at present Ms M Ansell is the (Acting) Interim Accountable Officer. Dr L Grewal confirmed that Dr Nimal-Raj is still a board member and the Safeguarding Lead.</p> <p>Dr N Tressider confirmed that Ostio Injections can begin, this can be discussed further with Mr J Andrews or Ms M Tompkins from the Medicines Management Team.</p> <p>Toe Nail Clipping services for none diabetic patients, it was discussed for Ms J Foster-Taylor to enquire into this service. Action JFT</p> <p>Dr V Devaraja to email Ms M Ansell and Ms J Foster-Taylor regarding issues with a private hospital. Action VD</p> <p>Dr A Deshpande confirmed that Mr R Pasumarthy is in post to offer support to practices for the bid process.</p>
