1. Welcome & Apologies

LJG introduced himself to the group as Lay Member and Deputy Chair of Thurrock CCG. Introductions were also made around the room.

Conflicts of interests – LJG asked if there were any conflicts of interest none were declared.

2. Vitamin D – Dr Anjan Bose

Dr Bose gave a very thorough presentation on the vitamin D needs of the human body.

The Chair informed the group that the presentation would be circulated and put on the CCG web site.

Dr Bose explained that it is a very easy Vitamin to obtain and a small blood test can be a good way of finding out if you are deficient or not.

The group asked if you are healthy would this mean you are deficient

Dr Bose replied that there are a lot of signs that would lead you to believe you could be deficient and to help you could eat oily fish and take cod liver oil.

The Chair thanked Dr Bose for a very good and interesting presentation.

3. SEEDS – Jo Harvey

Jo was asked to attend to outline what the SEEDS business brought to the Thurrock CCG and inform patient groups how it operates.

Jo explained that It was a patient out of hours service (OOH) which started in 1997

There are currently`15 surgeries in Thurrock that subscribe to this service. All other surgeries would have OOH services through the NHS E 111 service The service includes Bank Holidays and Xmas

It operated out of two centres one at BTUH and one at Long Land Grays

Jo advised the group that SEEDS work very closely with the CCGs to deliver a good OOH service.

There is a very low level staff turnaround which helps to keep the service consistent

SEEDS website have all relevant data and information

Jo was asked to identify what practices belonged to this service.

The Chair thanked Jo for her talk on the SEEDS service.

4. Walk in Centre – Rachel Halksworth

RH presented her data and findings on the elements of the walk in centre and asked the group for their feedback
