- A document has been produced to explain the proposed changes to the commissioning of local NHS services. At this stage the proposed changes wouldn't directly affect any services you may currently receive from hospitals or in primary care.

- Closing date for comments will be 31 March 2020.



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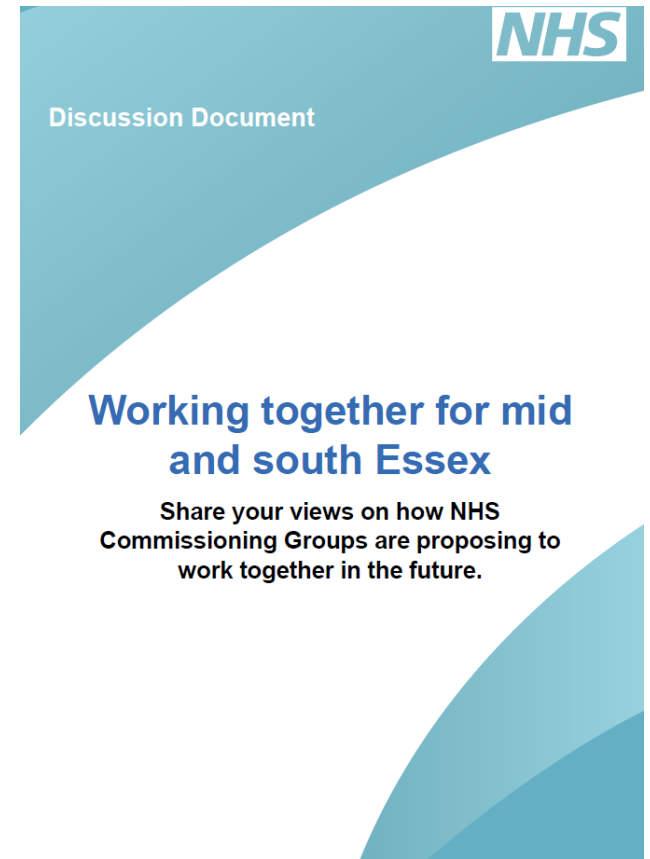
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The discussion document covers the benefits and reasons behind the proposal.
