

**MSE Hospitals Group Anticoagulation Clinics: Monitoring and supply of Vitamin k antagonists
(such as warfarin)**

Following on from Mid and South Essex CCGs COVID-19 GP e-briefing- Review of patients on Vitamin K antagonists to a suitable NOAC by MSE hospitals group anticoagulation clinics that was circulated on [21st April 2020](#).

During the Covid-19 pandemic the hospital monitoring and supply provision responsibilities for ongoing vitamin K antagonist anticoagulation e.g. warfarin will remain the same as existing arrangements. Patients will be referred to the appropriate phlebotomy service by the anticoagulation clinics.
