<b>3. <b>4. Transformation Hub update</b>	<p>Mr R Chaudhari gave a verbal update on weekend hubs. He informed that there are three working hubs and the fourth will be open from September 2015.</p> <p>RC gave an update on the Tilbury hub performance and informed that collaboration with CSU has been suggested in terms of level of expectations.</p> <p>RC requested that all comments regarding booking of appointments for weekend hubs should be shared by all GPs. He informed that these comments can be addressed during the monthly clinical meetings in order to implement them in the future.</p>
<b>5. IAPT Update</b>	<p>Dr Raj Mohile introduced Ms Jane Itangata and thanked her for her involvement in IAPT and mental health.</p> <p>Jl informed about national target stated by government regarding patient's appointments.</p> <p>Jl advised regarding the most common reasons that not enough patients are being referred:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Delayed after referring.</li> <li>2. <b>6. SEPT</b>	<p>Ms Kerry Coker shared a verbal update on the Therapy For You Service and introduced what services SEPT are offering, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Anxiety.</li> <li>• PSD.</li> <li>• OSD.</li> </ul>

- Anger management.
- Couples counselling.
- Home visits.
- Group therapies.
- 10 weeks program.

**Question:**

What is the expected wait time for therapy?

KC responded that it is matter of 6-12 weeks.

**Question:**

Can SEPT provide the transport?

KC advised that can be arranged.

**Question:**

What about referring patients with drug and alcohol addiction?

KC informed that SEPT will not offer the service for these patients. They will need to be referred to Addiction Service in the first instance. One of the SEPT services can be arranged after that.

KC updated on the query regarding pregnant patients.

The doctors at Peartree Surgery shared concern regarding fast track appointments.

RC responded for practice concerns.

**7. AOB**

Dr A Deshpande updated the membership regarding SEEDs and he advised:
