Her involvement is a vital part in Thurrock CCG. She will QIPP as also a valued member attends. 3. The new members of Business Support Team at Thurrock CCG were introduced to the attendees.

<p>3.</p>	<p>Commissioning update</p> <p>RC shared presentation about new programme for QIPP in 2015. New target of 7.2m for 2015 has been introduced. A question was raised regarding effectiveness of new plans for QIPP budget.</p> <p>LG advised that in order to use it efficiently we will need to working directly with providers instead of cutting on the service.</p> <p><u>The following questions were asked following the presentation:</u></p> <p>Question: Why only 10 programmes have been mentioned in presentation?</p> <p>AD responded that there are 40 programmes from which only top ten has been highlighted regarding dermatology, diabetics, children services a several from the hospitals we are currently working with.</p> <p>Question: With regards to CAMHS what support can be provided for those under 16 as there is not sufficient help at the moment?</p> <p>LG advised that NELFT won the contract although it won't be effective till December 2015. It's been suggested to contact directly clinicians. The update for the concern will be provided at the next CEG meeting.</p> <p>Action:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To contact directly clinicians in order to establish what support can be provided to under 16. <p>AD shared information that 20 families have responded for questionnaire and result has been reviewed. Case by case will be taken under consideration with regards to the CAMS support. LG will be presenting results started from 1st November 2015.</p> <p>LG answered that all board papers will be available after they will be accepted. New QIPP budget ideas and suggestions currently are due to review by CCG.</p> <p>It's been brought to attention that RRAS Service numbers slightly change. Update will be available on the website shortly.</p> <p>Action: Update for new RRAS Service number.</p>
<p>4.</p>	<p>Anticoagulation</p> <p>MT shared the presentation and informed that the main aim was to find the right pathway for anticoagulation with Dr Shankari and Dr Phen.</p> <p>It's been brought to the attention that these documents providing with national point of view for Warfarin.</p>

	<p>Dr Phen suggested making the pathway available on SINS in order to be clear. It's been informed that CCG currently working with hospitals to make it more transparent.</p> <p>Dr Shankari suggested that there are two options between new and old anticoagulants. As result of that review it has been agreed that there is no need to proceed often than on annually basis.</p> <p><u>The following questions were asked following the presentation:</u></p> <p>Question: How to calculate dose ranges?</p> <p>MT responded that coagulant cannot be calculated in surgeries and that she will have to update this information as it hasn't been mentioned in presentation. It's been suggested that it would be beneficial to have these information on the leaflet.</p> <p>MT informed that we are raising contract log with all the issues. Letters will be provided to Thurrock CCG to track results.</p> <p>Concern has been raised that Basildon was using old medication.</p> <p>With regards to a question about new agreements Dr Shankari advised that we have to make sure that all of the contracts are falling to the hospital not to individual consultant.</p>

Question has been raised for more awareness about flu jobs for pregnant patients. 3. Electronic systems SMS doesn't work correctly. AO will review the issue and update will be available on the next CEG meeting. 4. MSK patient details for issues with connect with New Castle. 5. Some of the patients has been discharged without giving the letter and has to be referred again. LG responded that serious concerns with services have been raised and steps have been taken. KPI patients have to be contacted within first 48 hours. 6. The issue with new cardiology appointments referral has to be addressed with NK. 7.
